- As a result of this continued misuse of the homes by a few members, the Board has adopted the following policy.

‘ A Welfare Society representative may check to ensure that the identity of those in residence are the member/partner/ spouse who made the booking.

If it is found that the member /partner/ spouse is not occupying the home the member who made the booking will be charged treble the current rate applying and may have their membership of the Welfare Society terminated’.

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
